THE WITTING TREE PROJECT

The term "witting" means to be cognizant, deliberate, and aware to the facts of a situation. Each year, more than a dozen faith communities and organizations join in hosting a Witting Tree ceremony at their sites.

We participate in the Witting Tree project by hanging 22 sets of dog tags on a tree in our church side yard (near our sign on Martello Drive) in public remembrance of 22 veterans who take their lives each day by suicide. (That is one Veteran that takes their life every 80 minutes.)

May each of us be committed to Scouting's ideals which instruct us to lead better lives, to be better citizens and to be a better example of leadership.




